Alsons Industries started as a clock-making company in 1953 but later began producing high-tech engineering products. In 1992, they opened Alsons Auto Parts (Pvt) Ltd to make car parts, and in 1993, they started exporting to France, Belgium, Germany, and Italy. Recently, the company has expanded into energy, home appliances, and consumer lighting sectors. Their facilities include CNC turning, milling, testing calibration, aluminum die casting, and assembly lines for aerospace, automotive, lighting, medical devices, and power components.
